
Some customers may comment on a discoloration or black stain on the paint of the brake calipers.

This may be caused by high brake pad temperatures during aggressive driving or track event tarnishing the caliper paint.

Correction

Important: Do *NOT* replace the brake calipers for this condition.

This is not a defect in the paint or the caliper.

If the customer wishes to have the black stain removed, a very mild polishing compound can be used to remove the stain.

Important: Do NOT use harsh chemicals or brake cleaner to attempt

to remove the stain. This could damage the paint on the caliper.
