
The blue connector referenced in the chart, step 3, should be a brown connector.

### INDICATOR LAMP CIRCUIT (OPEN CIRCUIT)

NOTE: IF IGNITION IS TURNED "ON," WHEN CLUSTER FUSE IS REMOVED OR BLOWN, THIS CODE WILL SET. ALSO, AN INTERMITTENT OPEN IN THE "INFL REST" INDICATOR CIRCUIT OR A DISCONNECTED DIC CONNECTOR WILL SET THIS CODE.
