If difficulty is noted in the removal of the steering wheel on 1990-91 Y-cars when using the correct special tools, J-1 859-03 (steering wheel puller) and J-38720 (puller side screws) it is suggested that the alternative method of using these tools be tried as indicated below:

- 1. Install wheel puller and side screws, insuring side screws are shouldered out on steering wheel hub.
- 2. Back out each side screw one (1) revolution from the shouldered out position and retighten wheel puller center screw.
- 3. Alternately tighten each side screw 1/4 turn.

NOTICE: TIGHTENING SIDE SCREWS MORE THAN A 1/4 TURN AT A TIME MAY RESULT IN DAMAGE TO THE STEERING WHEEL.

Utilizing the above procedure will generate a rocking force on the wheel and may assist in disengaging wheel from the shaft.
