## 1974 Corvette: Service News: Removal of Corvette Front Speakers

The front speaker removal procedure found on page 15-8 of the 1974 Chevrolet Passenger Car Service Manual has been revised.

The revised procedure is as follows:

Corvette Speaker (Left Side)

## Replacement

- 1. Disconnect battery ground cable.
- 2. Loosen windshield top garnish molding and remove windshield left side and right side garnish moldings.
- 3. Remove right side dash pad.
- 4. Remove one screw from instrument panel reinforcement and one screw from center console.
- 5. Lift up on instrument panel top pad and disconnect speaker connection.
- 6. Remove instrument panel.
- 7. Remove screws securing speaker to underside of instrument panel pad and then remove speaker.
- 8. To reinstall, Reverse Steps 1-7. **CAUTION:** *Always attach speaker connection before applying power to radio.*
- 9. Check speaker operation.

Corvette Speaker (Right Side)

## Replacement

- 1. Disconnect battery ground cable.
- 2. Remove three upper screws and two outer screws securing right dash pad. Pull dash pad out slightly to expose speaker and speaker connector.
- 3. Disconnect speaker connector.
- 4. Remove four nuts on underside of instrument panel pad securing speaker and remove speaker.

- 5. To reinstall, Reverse Steps 1-4. **CAUTION:** *Always attach speaker connector before applying power to radio.*
- 6. Check speaker operation.
